How many children per day?

Our programme operates with a maximum of 8-10 children per day to ensure a safe, well-supported and high-quality learning environment.

Do children need to be toilet trained?

Yes, children attending Mini Minds are expected to be toilet trained and able to manage their own toileting needs with minimal support, in line with our school-readiness focus.

Does Mini Minds follow the Early Years Learning Framework? (EYLF)

Yes. Our program is informed by the Early Years Learning Framework (EYLF v2.0) and aligns with key early learning outcomes while maintaining a clear focus on school readiness.

Is immunisation mandatory at Mini Minds?

As Mini Minds operates as a School Readiness and Early Learning Program rather than a registered Childcare Centre, immunisation records are not required for enrolment.

What does a typical day look like?

Each day includes a balance of:

- Literacy and numeracy learning
- Fine motor activities (cutting, writing, hands-on tasks)
- Gross motor, movement and dance
- Play-based learning
- Social skills, routines and independence-building activities
